Truth

- Follow the classroom rules
- All student work must be authentic. Students are not permitted to copy the work of another person. This includes published work on the internet. *Plagiarism is never acceptable.*
 - All work must be cited if you are using an image, quote, fact or data that is not your own.

Scholarship

- Be on time and be prepared for class. This includes books and necessary supplies to complete the work.
- All class assignments are due on the day assigned
- Any assignment not turned in on the designated day will be given “0” credit
- All homework must be turned in at the beginning of class. Students will not be permitted to return to his/her locker once class has started.

Excellence

- Draft Copies
 - Student drafts must be legible.
 - Student draft copies may be written in pencil or typed
 - All work must be turned in on neat and complete notebook paper
 - No frilly edges or ripped paper please
- Final Written Copies
 - All work must be free of grammar and spelling errors
 - Written in ink in *cursive* style unless otherwise stated
 - Typed
 - 12” font in black ink and 1” margins

- Final Poster or Visual Work
 - Signature in bottom right hand corner
 - Citations if necessary
 - Use a ruler
 - Use markers for captions
 - Use colored pencils or crayons for coloring
 - Outline all illustrations
 - Erase pencil lines
 - Work should be free of spelling and grammar errors
 - You have clearly conveyed the information
- Final Power Point Presentations
 - Clear connection to information
 - Title slide
 - Bibliography page
 - Work should be free of spelling and grammar errors.
